Use it as a novelty bookmark or a surprise insert in a greeting card. It make a wonderful talking point, "what on earth is that?!" , to share with your friends.

Print the model onto cardboard and follow the instructions to make your very own Snap-Up Squid.

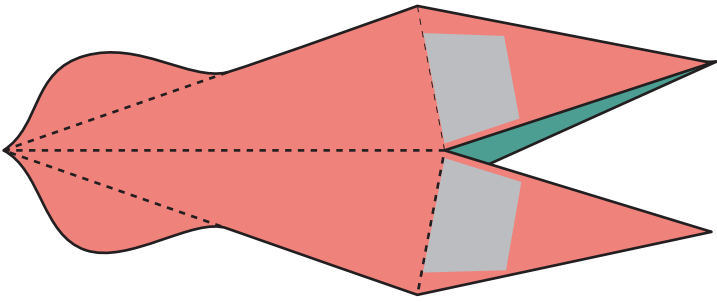

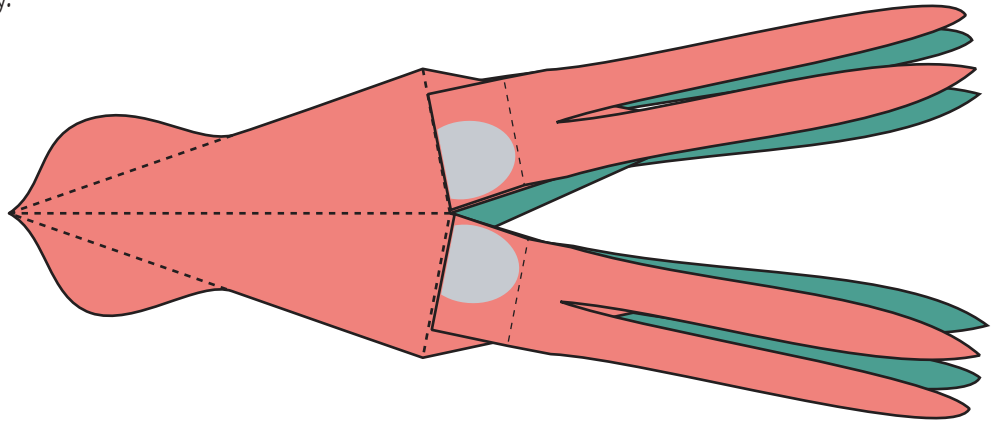
# Snap-Up Squid

Print out the model onto cardboard, reversing the card in the printer to print on the back. Leave the ink to dry thoroughly before making the model.

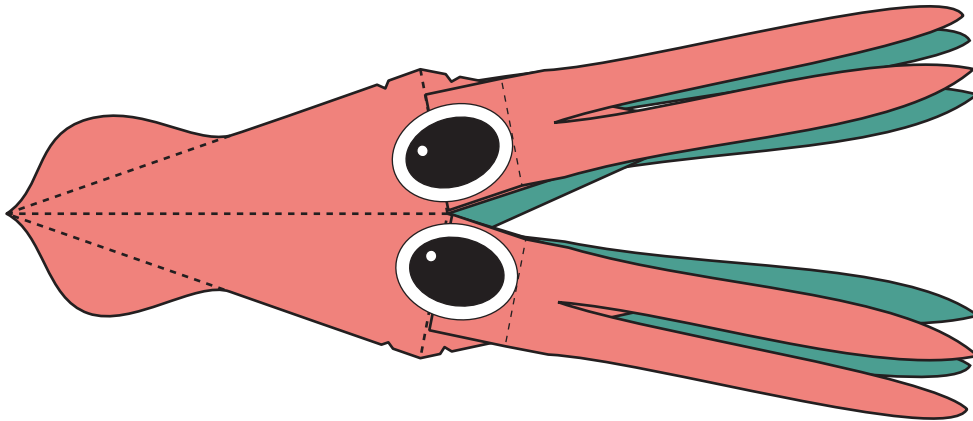
Before cutting out the model score along all the dotted lines.



Glue together the front and back of the body.



Fold the tentacles and glue them into place.



Glue on the eyes.  
Cut out the notches  
for the elastic band holes.

Thread a thin elastic band into place.  
Tweezers are useful for this.  
Tie the elastic band with a double knot
